



CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS DESIGN COMPETITION, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

The 103rd Street School design incorporates universal design and the concept of smaller schools within a larger framework. The design concept is a series of layers, marked by folded planes, that modulate the transition between the neighborhood and the security of the school. A central east-west interior street links the four schools (1 preschool and 3 grades 1 through 8), administration and shared spaces such as the gymnasium, library and dining areas.
