By “capturing” one pavilion inside another, the design of this new 7,000 square foot headquarters symbolizes both the permanence of the credit union and its openness to the public. The human scale of the smaller pavilion defines the entry, while the colonnade of the larger pavilion symbolizes the permanence and durability of the institution. The precedent for the design is the Florentine basilica and the Wisconsin barn. Thus, the Midwestern landscape is linked with a larger architectural tradition.
