The residence is inserted into the ruins of a factory - only the common brick walls remain. The street facade is defined by two galvanized metal scissors doors, which open to reveal the garage on the left and the garden on the right. The enclosure of the house is described by a warped steel frame suspended from the surrounding masonry walls and supported in the center by a grid of columns. The interior is anchored by a back/dressing room in one corner and the kitchen in the other, nothing more.
