



UIC VISUALIZATION LABORATORY, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

Located in the Art and Architecture building on the east end of UIC's campus, the 3,800 SF Visualization lab supports the Architectural and Industrial design curriculums. It includes 58 new computer workstations, support spaces and offices. The three separate studios that make up the lab are separated by roll down doors that can be raised to allow large scale seminars. The work done in the Visualization Lab supports the school's Virtual Reality Lab, also designed by VDTA.
